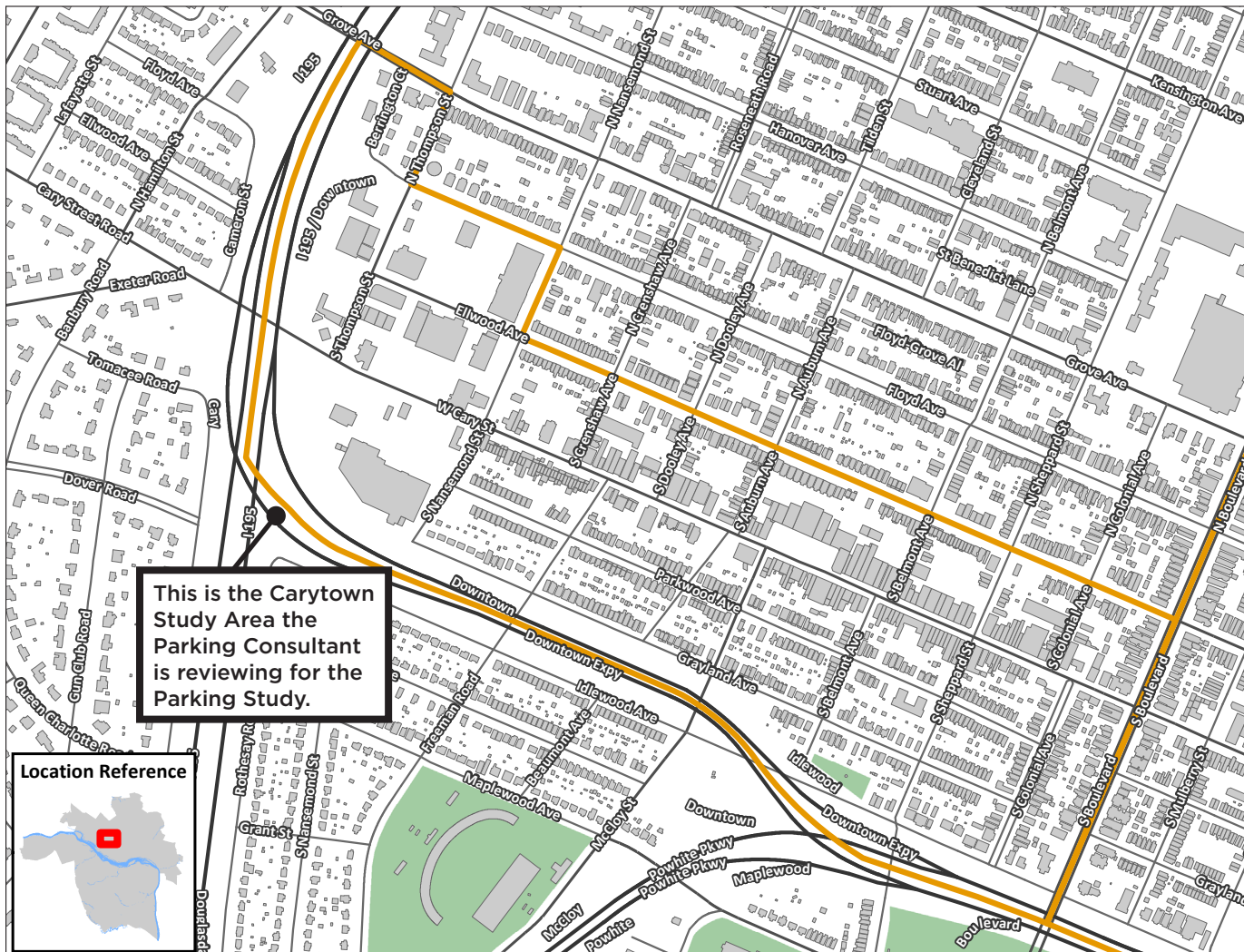


Come to the Carytown Parking Meeting!
