

City of Richmond: On-Street Parking Regulations

- Distance between intersection and start of parking lane:
20' from crosswalk whether marked or unmarked
- Distance between curb cut and start of parking lane:
5' for a residential driveway and 10' for a commercial driveway
- Distance between fire hydrant and start of parking lane:
15'
- Length of each parallel parking space:
22' midblock, 20' on ends
- Width of each parallel parking space:
7' minimum 8' desirable
- Width of each travel lane:
10' minimum
- Distance from Fire Station Driveway:
15' minimum
- Distance from Railroad grade Crossing:
50' minimum

Illustration of On-Street Markings

- The **white** curb designates passenger pick up or drop off.
- The **yellow** curb can be for loading zones or limited time parking.
- The **blue** curb is for disabled persons with proper vehicle identification.
- The **red** curb is for emergency vehicles only – fire lanes (no stopping, standing, or parking).
